Sir / Madam,

This is in continuation of the Board's letter of even number dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 from the Deputy Secretary (Exam) on the subject cited above.

In the light of the past experiences of the Board in conduct of the Common Written Examinations for filling up positions of Technical Assistant (T-3) and Technician (T-1) in the various ICAR institutes on a common day and the consequent unintended disadvantageous position to such of those applicants who might have applied for more than one institute, the Board has decided to conduct the said examination in on-line mode with appropriate options from such candidates.

The Board is in the process of finalizing the modalities for inviting and preparing a common data-base of all such applicants and the same shall be publicized in some leading newspapers and in the websites of the Board and ICAR.

The Board proposes to conduct a common examination through computer based on-line mode on date(s) and venue(s) to be notified shortly.


Since some of the participating institutes have issued the admit card and some are in the process of issuing the admit cards for the examination tentatively scheduled on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 in conventional mode the same may be treated as null and void / may be withheld. The admit cards shall now be centrally issued by the Board subsequently for all these candidates irrespective of their choice of institute.

The Board has separately issued an advertisement in some of the leading newspapers and further details may be accessed in the website of the Board.

It is requested that these developments may kindly be appropriately publicised in the individual websites of the concerned institutions for information of all the prospective candidates for the position of LDC.

Any inadvertent inconvenience caused in this regard is sincerely regretted.
